1. Purchase Preference (Centre)

Bid reserved for Make In India products: Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local suppliers as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document 50%. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. The deployment of the 05 nos. of School Buses (52-seater capacity) of Tata, Eicher, Mahindra or any other equivalent make (New or Not more than 10 years old) will be for a period of 03 years/810 days (approx. 270 days annually) for 12 hrs. engagement per day with provision of further extension of 01+ 01 year (one year at a time) at the same rate, terms and conditions on satisfactory performance with mutual agreement of the management and the service provider.

3. POL (Petroleum, Oil and lubricants) will be borne by the seller and reimbursement will be made on the basis of 1 litre Diesel Oil for 3 kms and 1 litre mobil for 300 kms run as per the certified log book entry of the User department. The rate of diesel for a particular month shall be as per the communication received from IE department of ECL HQ.

4. The bills will be raised in 2 segments, Part 1 (for Hiring Charges) and Part 2 (The payment for cost of Diesel). The Diesel price will be paid on the basis of total kilometer run (as certified by user department) divided by the mileage (as mentioned above) at the price as derived from the average price of Diesel for a particular month which will be communicated by IE Department of ECL HQ in the 1st week of succeeding month. User department will certify the satisfactory performance of the work at the time of processing the Bill.

5. The driver payment needs to be done through Bank (drivers name) from the owners banking name and style.

6. The vehicle must be ready to ply as per requirement of work and drivers should be conversant with the traffic rules & regulations and other related regulations / norms. In special case if the vehicle is required to be deployed within or outside the operating areas of ECL for a temporary period, the cost incurred for any additional permission / road permit/ Toll tax shall be reimbursed on actual basis on submission of documentary evidence.

7. Contractor must be ready to engage their vehicle anywhere under the control of Satgram-Sripur Area and decision of General Manager will be final and binding regarding engagement of the School Bus.

8. Monthly fuel quota for each school bus will be decided after placing the contract. Fuel consumption above the allotted quota will be reimbursed only after prior approval of the competent authority.

9. **PENAL CLAUSE:** In case of breakdown of the vehicle the awardee will have to make an alternative arrangement for providing vehicle with similar condition and information in this respect should be given to the management. If under any circumstance, the vehicle does not report for duty on any day, penalty @ double the awarded hire charges per day will be deducted from the bill.
